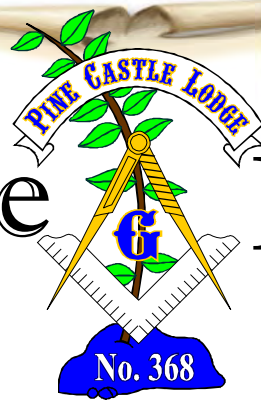

All the resolutions were either passed or failed as the jurisprudence committee recommended. Be aware that an "emergency" resolution was brought up before the delegates to raise the per-capita tax from the current \$14 to \$22. This same resolution would have made an automatic change to each particular lodge's by-laws to add the tax "in addition to" the dues. This means that if passed, your dues would go from \$120 to \$142. The resolution DID NOT pass so there will be no per-capita tax increase this year. Just be aware that they WILL try to get it passed in the future one way or another.

As you know, our 2nd BBQ is right around the corner on the 9th. Our Junior Warden is working very hard to make this a great event. We will be having a silent auction during the BBQ with some great items to be auctioned off including Disney Tickets, jewelry, hand made baby blankets, etc. There is also still time to DONATE some items for the auction.
